#### FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

Life continues to be busy at BPPS with swimming over for our PP – Yr 3 but we still have another week to go for our Yr 4 -6 students. Last week, our amazing choir participated in a music workshop at Southern Grove PS with a number of other schools. Teachers continue to deliver high quality programs and recently all staff attended the initial professional learning session on our new school Social and Emotional Learning program 'Highway Heroes'. Staff have another session next week and we will be holding a parent session in Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> August, so you may want to put that date in your diaries.

We are about to launch and trial a new academic program targeted at girls in maths. This will be offered to identified female students in Yrs 3-6 and run by Mrs Van Dam. They work tirelessly to support the school community and provide additional funds for school projects. This week they have set up a Mother's Day stall to provide the opportunity for students to purchase something wonderful for that special person in their lives.

Staff will be working on information for our upcoming school review in Week 11 of this term and receiving PL on independent workstations from School of Special Educational Needs and Disability.


